Before and After School Guidelines Main Site and Bidi

At Brabham Primary School, the safety and wellbeing of our students is our highest priority. To help ensure all children are safe, school playgrounds, play spaces and sporting equipment are not to be used before or after school due to the lack of staff supervision during these times. This applies across both Main Site and Bidi to maintain consistent safety expectations for all families.

Guidelines

School Grounds and Equipment

- Playground equipment, play spaces and sporting equipment must not be used before or after school.
- This applies to all areas of the school, including Main Site and Bidi, even when a parent or adult is present.
- Before and after school, students are to remain in designated waiting areas only.

Gate Access and Security

Main Site:

- Gates open: 8:20 am
- Classrooms open: 8:35 am (Years 1–6)
- Teaching begins: 8:50 am
- Gates lock: 9:00 am
- School finishes: 3:00 pm
- Gates lock: 3:10 pm
- The back gate near the basketball courts will remain open for OSH families only.

Bidi (Kindy and Pre-Primary):

- Gates open: 8:20 am
- Classrooms open: 8:30 am
- Teaching begins: 8:40 am
- Gates lock: 8:40 am
- School finishes: 2:40 pm
- Gates lock: 2:50 pm

Expectations

Before School

- Children should ideally arrive close to classroom opening times.
- If arriving at main site before classrooms open, students and families must wait in the designated undercover area.
- If arriving at the Bidi site before classrooms open, students and families must wait outside their classrooms.
- Students must not play on playgrounds, courts, oval spaces or other school equipment before school.

After School

- Students are expected to leave school grounds promptly at the end of the school day unless attending OSH.
- Families are asked to collect children promptly and depart the site safely.
- Playgrounds and play equipment are reserved for OSH use only after school.
