

Parking Guidelines

Safe Parking and Pick Up for All Families

At Brabham Primary School, student safety is our highest priority. The beginning and end of each school day are busy times, with high volumes of traffic, pedestrians and children moving around our school grounds. For this reason, safe parking, careful supervision and following school traffic procedures are essential to protecting every member of our community.

We ask all families to carefully follow the guidelines below to help reduce congestion, prevent accidents and ensure students arrive at and leave school safely. Every safe choice made by families contributes to a calmer, safer environment for our entire school community.

Brabham Primary School has several parent parking options available around the school, including:

- Parent parking on Palfrey Street (near basketball court)
- Parent parking along Lakefield Drive (front of school)
- Parent parking on Camballin Way (outside Teal and Blue Block)
- Parent parking off Fairmount Boulevard (Bidi)
- Additional surrounding street parking where permitted

Choosing safe parking locations, following traffic directions and avoiding unsafe stopping or crossing practices are critical to student safety.

If your family is able to walk or ride to school, we strongly encourage this as a healthy, active and often safer option that also helps reduce traffic congestion around the school.

Staff Parking

- Staff parking bays and designated staff parking areas are reserved for staff only
- Parents and visitors must not park in staff allocated bays at any time

Teal and Blue Block Carpark

- The Teal and Blue Block carpark includes allocated parent parking bays
- Traffic flow in this carpark is one way only and all drivers must follow signage and road markings
- If no parent parking bays are available, families will be required to continue moving and loop around rather than stopping illegally, blocking traffic or creating unsafe conditions
- Please do not stop in throughways, queue across active traffic areas, or create congestion that may place children at risk

Important:

- The Bus Bay is strictly for bus use only
- Parents must not park, wait, stop, or use the Bus Bay for drop off or pick up at any time

Kiss and Drop Options

Lakefield Drive (Front of school)

Our front Kiss and Drop zone is a convenient option for both morning drop off and afternoon pick up and is designed to maximise student safety while maintaining efficient traffic flow.

Morning Drop Off (8:15 - 8:50am):

- Families may use the front Kiss and Drop zone to safely drop students off before school

- Parents pull into the Kiss and Drop zone, students exit the car safely onto the school side, and parents then drive off immediately

Afternoon Pick Up (3:00 - 3:15pm):

- Multiple staff members supervise this area each afternoon to support student safety
- Students are supervised while waiting
- Vehicles must continue moving forward at all times
- Students should wait until their family car is within the first four cars before entering the vehicle

This system is designed to keep children safe, reduce traffic build up and ensure smooth movement of vehicles.

Important Safety Expectations:

- Parents must not park in the Kiss and Drop Zone
- Parents must never call children through traffic to reach their vehicle
- If your child is not ready and waiting when you reach the front of the line, you will be asked to either:
 - Loop around again, or
 - Park legally and collect your child in person

This process is essential for maintaining safety, supervision and traffic flow.

Kiss and Drop on Palfrey Street (Near basketball court)

- The rear Kiss and Drop area is available for quick drop off or collection
- This area is not supervised by Brabham Primary School staff
- Families may pull in, safely drop off or collect their child, and then drive off
- Parents are responsible for ensuring their child's safety at all times in this area
- Parents must not park nearby and direct children to cross roads or traffic independently

Respectful and Safe Behaviour

- Students must never walk through moving traffic independently to access parked vehicles
- If you choose to park your vehicle, families are expected to leave their car, safely meet their child, and escort them back to the vehicle
- Please follow all staff directions during peak times
- Please be patient, respectful and courteous to supervising staff
- Staff are working hard to keep all children safe and traffic moving as efficiently as possible
- Unsafe parking, illegal stopping, blocking traffic, or calling children through traffic places everyone at serious risk

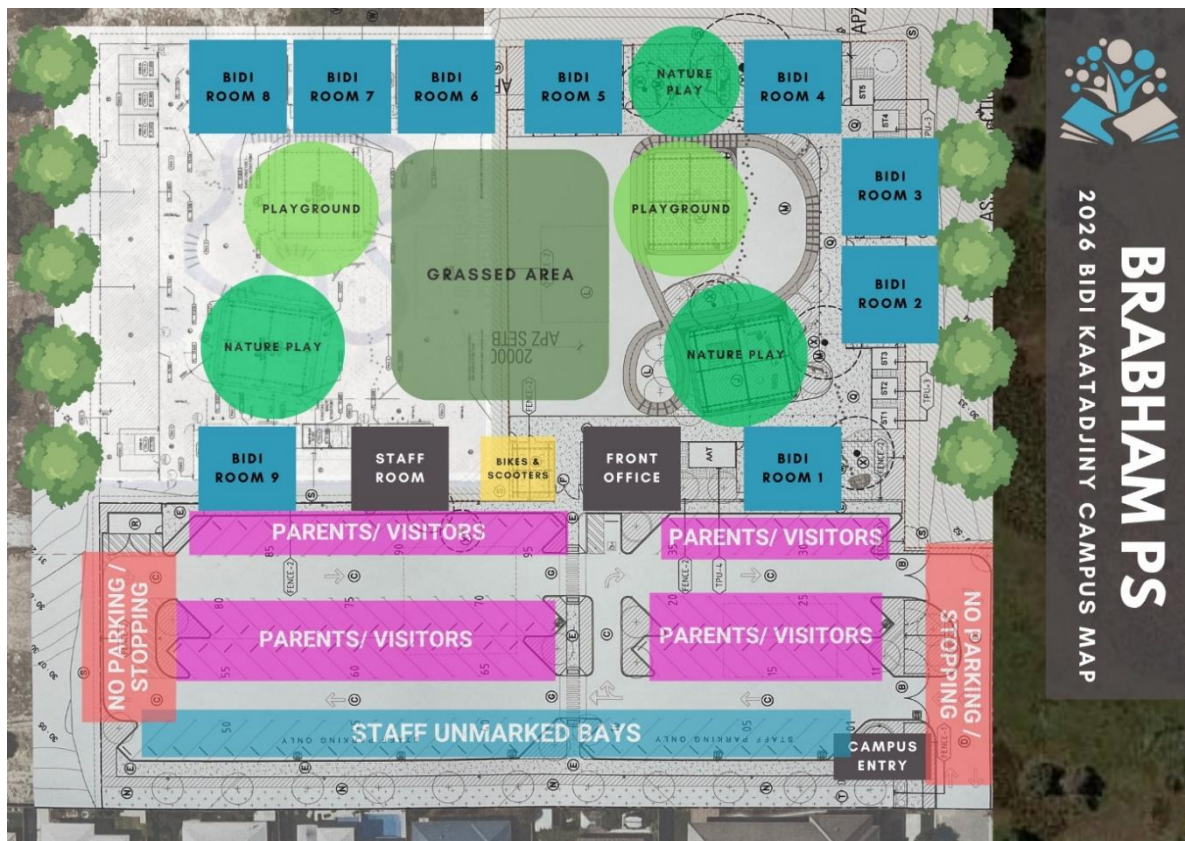
Our Shared Goal
